## THE NICENE CREED

Leader Let us confess our faith, as we say,

**All We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen.**

**We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, of one being with the Father. **BATTLE OF THE ATLANTIC SUNDAY** — On the first Sunday in May, the Anglican Church of Canada commemorates the sacrifices of more than 4,600 Canadian sailors, merchant seamen, airmen, and soldiers who gave their lives in the North Atlantic during the Second World War. The elements were as vicious as the foe, with raging storms, pack ice, bitter cold, fog, and the dense darkness of North Atlantic nights. 24 ships and 350 aircraft were lost. Yet the convoys made nearly 26 thousand safe crossings and carried 200 million tonnes of vital supplies from Canada to Great Britain. We will remember them.
