**BATTLE OF THE ATLANTIC SUNDAY** — On the first Sunday in May, the Anglican Church of Canada commemorates the sacrifices of more than 4,600 Canadian sailors, merchant seamen, airmen, and soldiers who gave their lives in the North Atlantic during the Second World War. The elements were as vicious as the foe, with raging storms, pack ice, bitter cold, fog, and the dense darkness of North Atlantic nights. 24 ships and 350 aircraft were lost. Yet the convoys made nearly 26 thousand safe crossings and carried 200 million tonnes of vital supplies from Canada to Great Britain. We will remember them.
