Leader The Lord be with you.

Leader We give you thanks for your Holy Spirit who teaches us and leads us into all truth, filling us with his gifts so that we might proclaim the gospel to all nations and serve you as a royal priesthood.

Leader We give you thanks for you have called Novalie Rayne, Amirah Mae, Hayley Michelle, Tristan William George and Nyla Shyanna to new life through the waters of baptism.

Now sanctify this water, that your servants who are washed in it may be made one with Christ in his death and resurrection, to be cleansed and delivered from all sin. Leader Will you strive for justice and peace among all people, and respect the dignity of every human being?

All I will, with God's help.

Leader Will you strive to safeguard the integrity of God's creation, and respect, sustain and renew the life of the earth?

All I will, with God's help.

THE BAPTISM

Leader *Hayley Michelle, Amirah Mae, Tristan William George, Novalie Rayne and Nyla Shyanna*, I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

All Amen.

Leader I sign you with the cross, and mark you as Christ's own for ever.

The celebrant, prays over the newly baptized, saying,

Heavenly Father, we thank you that by water and the Holy Spirit you have bestowed upon these your servants the forgiveness of sin, and have raised them to the new life of grace. Sustain them, O Lord, in your Holy Spirit. Give them an inquiring and discerning heart, the courage to will and to persevere, a spirit to know and to love you, and the gift of joy and wonder in all your works.

Leader Receive the light of Christ, to show that you have passed from darkness to light.

All We receive you into the household of God. Confess the faith of Christ crucified, proclaim his resurrection, and share with us in his eternal priesthood.
